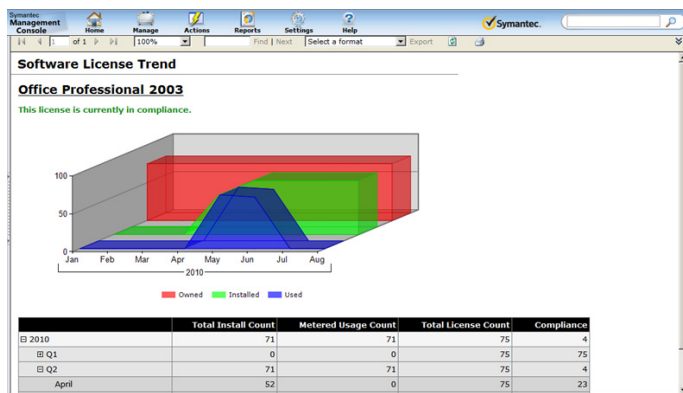
- View inventory, state, and cost of the hardware and software environment.

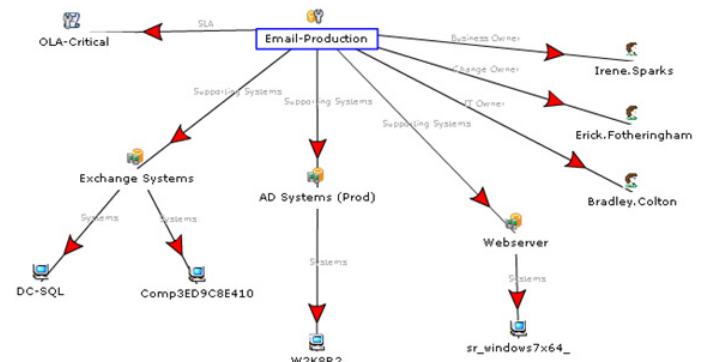
Visually track licenses owned, versus installed, versus used

Detailed asset report

Simplify audits

With all IT assets organized, Altiris Asset Management Suite allows managers to view the entire organization from a single management console, including the ability to create detailed asset reports needed to pass an audit. Every managed asset is actionable from the asset reports. Right-click actions include:

- Deliver software
- Uninstall software
- Request the user to confirm ownership

These quick tasks avoid the need for frequent desk-side visits or physical audits.

Measure and improve IT performance

In IT management, most decisions are based on highly formatted reports that can help you answer predetermined questions with little interaction or analysis from the user. When new questions arise or more information is required that is not included in the available reports, organizations often require technical expertise to properly mine and analyze data. Altiris™ Client Management Suite from Symantec contains advanced analytics and reporting that allow IT organizations to explore data and answer their own questions.

- View reports that provide a representative view of all IT assets including the ability to aggregate data from multiple configuration management database (CMDBs).
- Measure critical success factors and quickly assess trends of how these measures are changing over time.
- Construct ad-hoc reports using familiar pivot tables without advanced knowledge of databases or third-party reporting tools.

Single source configuration management database

Gain visibility into real-time asset information from a single source. This single source Configuration Management Database (CMDB) manages hierarchical relationships of assets, including assets to other configuration items, users, locations, departments, cost centers, and associated contracts.

- Ownership validation template allows IT to request asset owners to acknowledge possession of their resources.
- Hardware | Software request template automates steps for procuring equipment or software with links into financial systems, inventory, and company approvals.
- Lease notification template provides steps for appropriately returning leased assets and taking the specified steps to ensure the proper disposal and transfer of ownership or data to the new asset.
